AI-assisted writing using tools that are often embedded in writing software (for example Microsoft Word and Google Docs) are allowed for the purpose of improving the language and readability of submissions and with the appropriate disclosure within the body of the manuscript, typically in an 'Acknowledgement' section.

Authors are required to carefully and thoroughly review manuscript content, including AI-assisted content prior to submitting it to the ALJ.

AI-generated content is not currently allowed in manuscripts submitted to the Atlantic Law Journal. AI tools are not accountable for AI generated content. For this reason, the ALJ also does not accept manuscripts that credit AI tools with authorship.

The ALJ editorial team makes the final publishing decision regarding submissions including decisions concerning whether use of an AI tool is appropriate or permissible in the circumstances of a submitted manuscript. When AI generated content is found but not disclosed, we will take appropriate corrective action.
